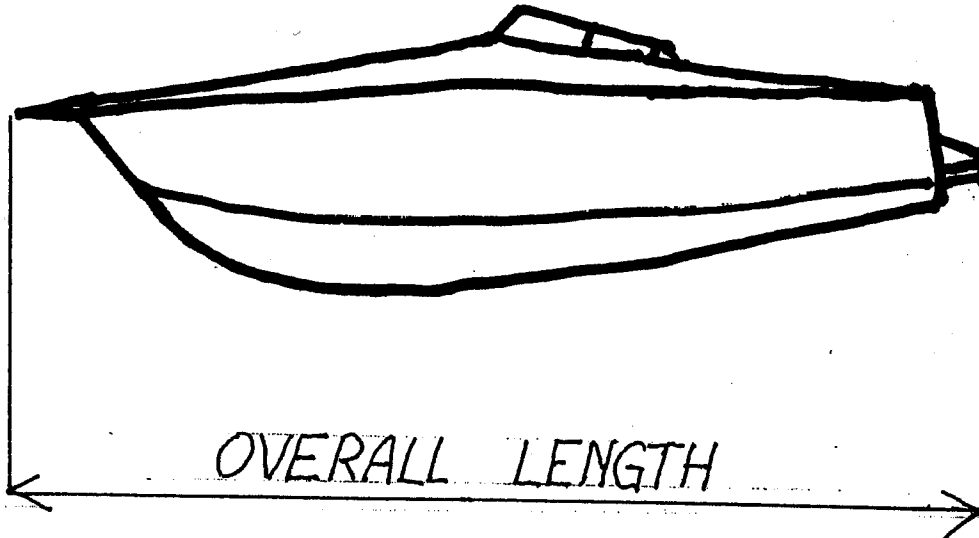


SOUTH DOWN BOAT CLUB BOAT LENGTH REQUIREMENTS



BERTH REQUIREMENTS: Boats utilizing dry berths shall be no more than 28 feet Length Overall (LOA) and shall weigh no more than 7,500 pounds with an 8'6" beam width. Length overall includes swim platforms, pulpits, the propulsion equipment in its most compact position, and anything else that would extend beyond the bow or stern.

It is recommended that the manufacturer be contacted as to the suitability of a boat for valet service before the boat is purchased. Configuration and padding of the stringers is the boat owner's responsibility. **Do not assume that a model already on site would fit into every berth.** There are some berths that are unable to accommodate certain models because of the length of the boat and/or the turning radius of the area where the berth is located.

SLIP REQUIREMENTS: Boats up to 35 feet LOA, as measured from furthestmost point of bow to furthestmost point of stern, inclusive of anchor, swim platform, and other pulpits, and weighing no more than 11,000 pounds with a 11' beam, are allowed at the docks provided no portion extends over the dock to interfere with the walkway when boat is tied.

PURCHASE OF NEW BOAT: When the purchase of a new boat is being contemplated, or when a boat is new to the facility, the buyer or new owner must submit certification in writing to the Management Company that the boat meets the boat size requirements as outlined above. The Management Company must grant approval in writing before the boat is brought to the South Down Boat Club facility. The Board of Directors have final authorization for a boat that does not fit into a dry berth or boat slip.
